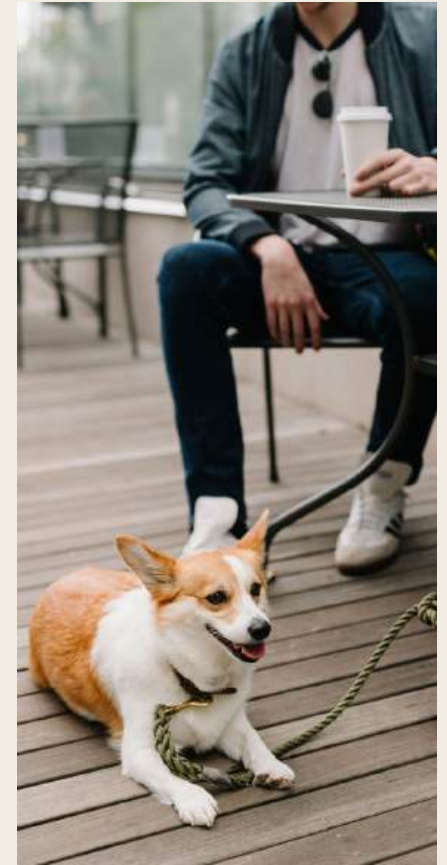
To ensure you have a woof of a good time, here are some of the best pet-friendly spots in the city.

Eades Park, West Melbourne

A leisurely 13-minute walk from Dorsett Melbourne is Eades Park, a designated dog off-leash park also home to open grassy areas, shady trees, a playground and fitness equipment. Take the route past Flagstaff Gardens, Melbourne's oldest parkland, for extra green scenery.

Gosch's Paddock, Melbourne CBD

If you love your pooch but love your sport too, head to Gosch's Paddock. It's a longer commute from the hotel but off-leash ovals, bordered by Swan Street and Punt Road, are worth the walk. This spot is best suited to more confident hounds, as it's also a popular cycling and running route.



The Angry Dog, West Melbourne

Quintessentially Melbourne, The Angry Dog is an industrial haven with touches of Art Deco and raw timber, housed in modern shipping containers. Stop for a beverage Tuesday and Wednesday, with food trucks serving (hotdogs Thursday – Saturday).



**Hardware Société,
Melbourne CBD**

A café born in the laneways of Melbourne, Hardware Société has ample outdoor seating to satisfy you and the hound. It's one of the city's best cafes but walk-in only; so go early to avoid the queues, and ensure you order the baked eggs with a side of bacon for your furry friend.

**Kirk's Wine Bar,
Melbourne CBD** For the hounds who love the finer things in life, look no further than alfresco dining at Kirk's & Wine Bar on Little Bourke Street. This iconic spot offers European vibes, a thoughtful wine selection and Parisian-style outdoor tables.

**Diggiddy Dog Daycare,
South Melbourne** Dogs cannot be left unattended in your room at Dorsett Melbourne, however we understand you may want to visit spots where hounds are not allowed. [diggiddydoggydaycare®](#) is a multi-award winning, indoor doggy daycare centre, located a 15-minute drive from the hotel. No wheels? Simply jump in a pet Uber.

**Everywhere,
Regional Victoria** If you're looking to explore further afield, good news! Dogs can travel with you on metro and regional trains, as long as they're on a lead and wearing a muzzle. Don't forget to check the PTV website, for rules when travelling with your hound on public transport.



Pet Policy

To ensure the comfort of you, your dog and the other guests at Dorsett Melbourne, there are a few guidelines that must be adhered to while staying at the hotel.

The hotel allows a maximum of one (1 dog per room for overnight stays and must be 20 kg or less (except for guide dogs). Any dog, regardless of breed, that shows aggression will be asked to be removed from the property.

Dogs must not be left unattended in guest rooms at any time. If a dog is found to be unattended, Management may use their discretion to ask you and your dog to leave. A non-refundable one-off cleaning fee (of \$100 per stay will be charged upon check-in for dogs. An additional penalty will be charged for dogs unreported and found in the room.

When outside your room, please be responsible. Dogs must be on leash at all times. If you wish to have your room serviced, please speak with our friendly team at reception as housekeeping must be completed while you and your dog are out.

You are responsible for any and all the property damage and/or personal injuries resulting from your dog.

Pet-Accessible Spaces

Pets (except for guide dogs) are not permitted in Port Bistro, Jin Bar or any other area that provides food service, including the Club Lounge. Dogs are prohibited from entering the pool, sauna and steam room on Level 7, and the gym on Level 8. Pets must not visit any level of the hotel other than the lobby and your room.
